“CELEBRATE - SCRAPBOOK PAGE”



Combine your love for machine embroidery with scrap booking to make this three dimensional scrapbook page.

Supplies:

Baby Lock Embroidery Machine
12"x12" beige paper
12"x12" mod square paper
8.5"x11" silver metallic paper
8.5"x11" moss green paper
3/4-yard beige grosgrain ribbon
1/2" pearl button
Sulky Sticky™
Moss green rayon thread
Invisible thread
Silver metallic pen
Ruler
Basic scrapbook supplies

Instructions:

Preparation:

- Cut One 3" x 12" strip of mod square paper
 - Cut Two 6-3/4" x 4-3/4" silver metallic paper
 - Cut Two 6-1/2" x 4-1/2" moss green paper
1. Hoop Sulky Sticky according to manufacture's instructions.
 2. Starting about 3" from end of ribbon, center the ribbon in the hoop; use the horizontal hoop markings for placement. Finger press the ribbon in place.
 3. Select embroidery letters for "**Celebrate**". Thread machine with moss green thread. Embroider the design onto the ribbon.
 4. Remove hoop from machine and gently tear the ribbon away from the Sulky Sticky. Trim thread ends and press.
 5. Thread machine with invisible thread.
 6. Form a bow in the ribbon, allowing for 8" tails. Make sure the embroidery is placed so it will be seen on the left tail. Secure the bow through the center, by stitching in place, with the sewing machine. Trim the ends of the tail into a "V".

Assembly:

1. Use adhesive to attach the 3" x 12" mod paper strip to the beige 12" x 12" paper, 3/4" from the edge.
2. Attach the moss green square to the silver metallic squares, with adhesive.
3. With a small amount of adhesive, secure the moss green/silver squares onto the beige paper.
4. With ruler, draw 2 metallic lines on both sides of the mod strip of paper.
5. Attach the bow to the center of the mod strip of paper, with adhesive.
6. Stitching in place with a zigzag stitch, sew the button to the center of the bow.
