



## “WHIMSICAL LOVE PILLOW”



This pillow features embroidery designs created by popular artist Jeanie Mooney, accented by the exclusive wave stitch from Baby Lock's Imagine Wave serger.

**FINISHED SIZE:** 14-inch square

### Supplies:

- Baby Lock Ellageo Sewing & Embroidery Machine
- 4-inch x 4-inch hoop for Ellageo
- Embroidery foot
- Baby Lock memory card Jeannie Mooney Collection I Cherish (BLEC-PO3)  
Featured designs: #12 and # 14
- Baby Lock Imagine Wave Serger

### Fabrics:

- ½ yard of 44/45-inch base fabric
- ¼ yard of white weaver's cloth
- ¼ yard of 44/45-inch contrasting color/pattern fabric
- 14-inch pillow form
- Tear-away stabilizer
- Machine embroidery threads (colors needed are listed on memory card)
- Bobbin thread
- Temporary adhesive fabric spray
- 1 spool serger thread to match fabric
- 2 spools YLI Pearl Crown Rayon to coordinate with fabric

## **Instructions:**

### **Cutting:**

- From base fabric, cut two 14-inch squares
- From white weavers cloth, cut two 6-inch squares
- From contrasting color/pattern fabric, cut two 9-inch squares

### **Embroidered Insets:**

1. Set up the Ellageo for embroidery. Load desired design from memory card.
2. Apply spray adhesive to the wrong side of the white weaver's cloth and apply the stabilizer. Hoop the fabric. Stitch out the first design using embroidery threads. Repeat this process for the second 6" square.
3. Remove the excess stabilizer. Centering the design, trim the embroidered weavers cloth leaving 1½ -inch edge on each side of design.
4. Set up the Ellageo for straight stitch sewing to stitch the embroidered weavers cloth pieces to the contrasting color/pattern fabric.
5. Using a ½-inch seam allowance (from right edge of embroidered weavers cloth) straight stitch the embroidered weavers cloth to the contrasting color/pattern fabric.
6. Centering the design, trim the contrasting color/pattern fabric leaving ½ -inch edge.
7. Set the Ellageo for a satin stitch, and sew the contrasting color/pattern fabric to the base fabric by applying the satin stitch on top of straight stitch from step 5.
8. Fray outer edge of white weaver's cloth on all four sides.

### **Pillow Assembly with Baby Lock Imagine Wave Serger:**

1. Set up the Imagine Wave for the Wave stitch with Pearl Crown Rayon thread in upper and lower loopers.
2. Serge the outer edge of the contrasting color/pattern fabrics to finish off the raw edges.
3. Place the wrong sides of the pillow together. Serge the left side, top, and right side of the pillow.
4. Insert pillow form.
5. Push the pillow form toward the top of pillow (May require an extra set of hands!).
6. Serge across the bottom of the pillow.

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
